

Cleanup Construction Activities

Construction is typically within standard working hours, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday. Movement of barges may occur outside of these work hours.

On Tuesday, December 17, the Contractor is expected to move equipment starting at 5 a.m. to Sediment Management Area (SMA) 2 and start work by 6 a.m. Early work will continue at SMA 2 for the next couple of days. Crews will continue installing sheet piles near SMA 9 which may cause higher noise levels during the daytime. Work in SMA 9 will continue for a couple of weeks. We thank community members in advance for your patience during this time.
