Lower Duwamish Waterway Cleanup Construction

The second season of cleanup construction on the Lower Duwamish Waterway is underway.

This season, the South Park-based contractor, Pacific Pile and Marine, will begin dredging contaminated sediment near the South Park Bridge, Duwamish Waterway Park, and Duwamish River People's Park. The community can expect multiple barges and equipment working on the water, lights for safe work during dark hours, and typical construction equipment noise.



Crews will be working on the waterway near the South Park Bridge at night on October 1–18, between the hours of 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. Crews will not be working on Sunday nights.

During this time, you may hear noise from construction equipment and see lights for safe work. Additional night work will occur this fall, and we will notify you as we get closer to that time.
