### Cleanup Construction Activities

Season 2 construction in the upper reach, the southernmost two miles of the Lower Duwamish Waterway Superfund site, will continue through February 2026. Season 2 construction will occur on weekdays and Saturdays, with **work taking place during both daytime and, when needed, nighttime hours.**

Work hours will vary based on factors such as tides and the type of work being conducted (e.g., dredging or placing clean material). Work will be coordinated with Tribal fishing.

Please note that in-water construction activities are dynamic and weather-dependent. All schedules are subject to change.

The first week and a half of cleanup construction was busy and productive for the construction team. We understand that nighttime work can be disruptive at times, and we would like to thank the neighborhood while we complete this important cleanup work.

Additionally, we appreciate your patience during the nighttime closure of the South Park Bridge on October 3, 4, 6 and 7. **Nighttime bridge closure of the South Park Bridge will not occur tonight, October 10 or tomorrow, October 11, as were tentatively scheduled for.** The construction team successfully completed the work beneath the bridge needed for this week.

You can expect additional South Park Bridge closures later this fall and winter.

LDWG and the construction team are coordinating closely with King County Road Services, Tribes, and other partners to keep everyone informed about when these closures will occur. We will provide advance notification to the community.

Closures will be announced through the LDWG Construction Email Newsletter, social media, flyers in the community, emails to local organizations, standard road closure signage, and by King County Road Services' [My Commute](#) platform: <https://gismaps.kingcounty.gov/mycommute/>.

## What to Expect During the Week of October 13

Cleanup activities will occur in **sediment management areas (SMAs) 12B, 14A, 14C, 14D, and 15A**. The work will occur during the daytime, starting as early as 6 a.m., near the Duwamish River People's Park, South Park Bridge, and Duwamish Waterway Park.

At times when the construction barges are near the South Park Bridge, recreational vessels should use caution when navigating around the construction equipment. The contractor has established an in-water safety buffer around any cleanup construction equipment and will warn (using either horn or voice) any recreational waterway users, such as kayakers, when they approach.
