Season 2 construction in the upper reach, the southernmost two miles of the Lower Duwamish Waterway Superfund site, will conclude at the end of February 2026, except as noted below.



### Environmental and Community Report for the Week of February 9

View Last Week's Environmental and Community Report



With oversight from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), we are working to minimize the impact of construction on those who work, live, and spend time along the Duwamish Waterway. Stay informed about environmental monitoring and construction activities by viewing our weekly report linked above.

### What to Expect During the Week of February 23

This is the final week of season 2 in-water work using barges, excavators, and tugs for cleanup activities.

Cleanup activities will include placing clean material in sediment management areas (SMAs) **9**, **11A**, and **12B**. These are areas where dredging is complete.

At SMA **9**, where the cleanup is complete, contractors will stage rocks for use in a gabion basket, a structure designed to prevent erosion of sediment from discharges at

an existing outfall.

Work will occur on weekdays and Saturday, between 6:30 a.m. and 6 p.m.


## What to Expect During the Week of March 2

A small crew will build the gabion basket at **SMA 9** during the low tide, concluding Season 2 work, while the barges and heavy equipment used for the cleanup activities are removed from the work areas.
